This project involves the removal of the existing bridge superstructure, repairs to the existing substructure and replacement with concrete deck beams, a five (5)-inch wearing surface, F-shaped parapets and rip rap protections to reduce scouring. The proposed improvement also includes reconstruction of Dauberman Road in advance of the bridge structure.
