Type a detailed description of the project:

The project includes the replacement of two reinforced concrete box culverts along LaFox Road. A twin Cell 8'x7' box culvert will be replaced with a 42' bridge span over Mill Creek. The 4'x6.5' box culvert will be replaced over an unnamed tributary flowing to Mill Creek. Construction also includes installed of a sheetpile wall along the west side of LaFox Road, reshaping of roadside ditches, replacement of culverts at the intersections of Grand Monde Road and LaFox Road, and general widening of LaFox Road through the project limits.
