FY 2018 BUILD PROGRAM

IDOT Long Range Transportation Plan

The Illinois Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) is now available for public comment through May 16, 2018. The plan provides strategic direction for the development of the Illinois transportation system. The LRTP vision for transportation in Illinois is to provide innovative, sustainable and multimodal transportation solutions that support local goals and grow Illinois' economy. This vision was established in conjunction with thousands of stakeholders who participated in outreach activities throughout the planning process. IDOT is required to complete a LRTP every five years, per state legislation. Statewide Planning and Research Funds Call for Projects

As part of the release of the LRTP, IDOT is completing a Call for Projects for Statewide Planning and Research Funds. These funds are eligible to internal and external parties and are used to support planning activities. Funding will help establish a cooperative, continuous and comprehensive framework for making transportation investment decisions and to help complete transportation planning and research activities throughout the state. Eligible activities include:

- Planning studies
- Data purchase, collection, and/or analysis
- Program development activities
- Performance management activities
- Coordination/outreach activities

All proposed projects should be related to further studying or implementing a goal, strategy or objective within the LRTP or one of its associated plans, implementing asset management, or working towards developing a performance based program development process.

IDOT will evaluate the project based on its ability to further one of those three topics. A 20 percent match will be required. Additional information can be found here: <https://goo.gl/svyPcn>

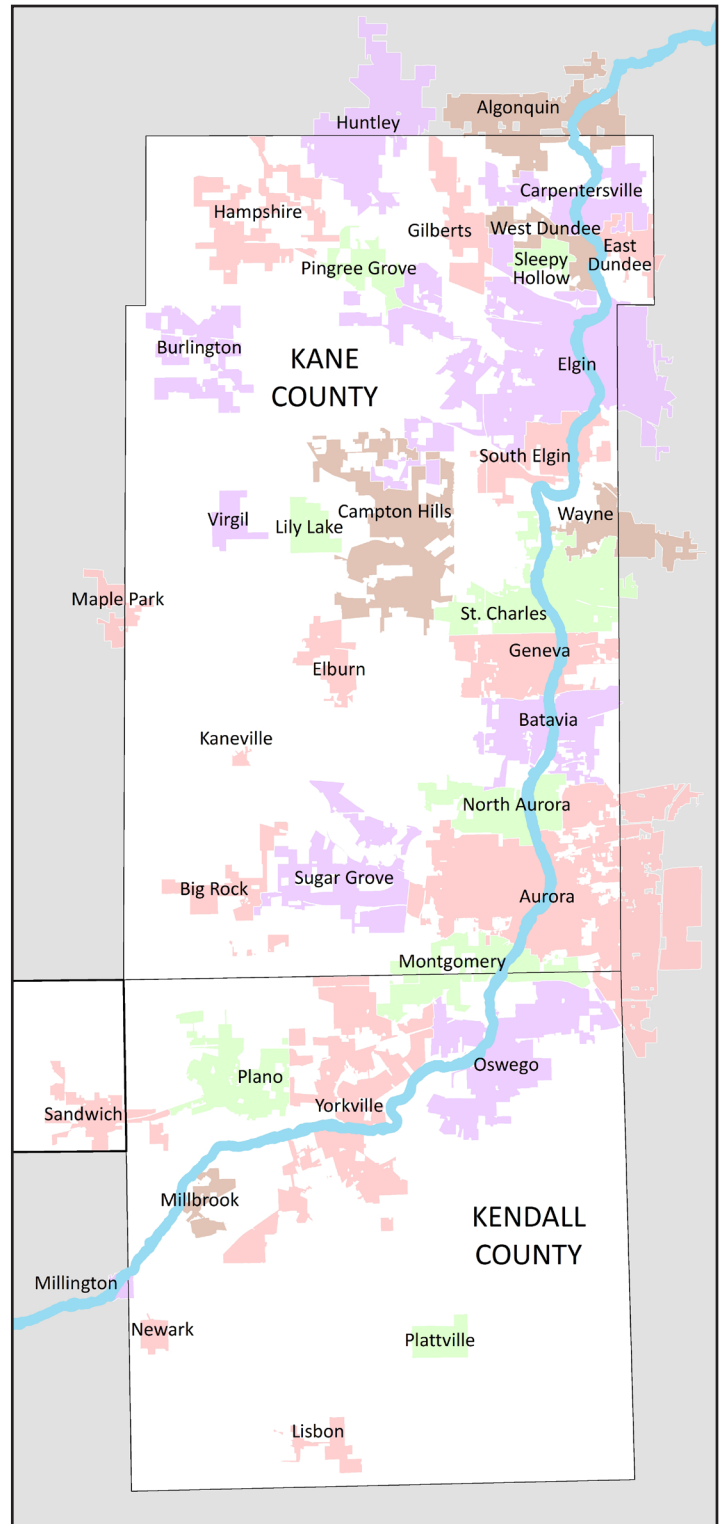

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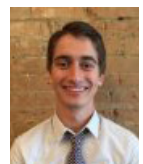
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
