The Kane County Division of Transportation is in need of professional services from a qualified engineering firm to provide Phase Two Engineering. The attached *Preliminary Scope of Services* provides in detail anticipated items that are necessary as part of this project.

At this time the County anticipates starting this work in mid 2008 with contract duration of 18 calendar months.

The Statement of Interest shall be submitted **VIA EMAIL** no later than 4:00 P.M. on February 29, 2008 and should be addressed to Mr. Paul Holcomb, Chief of Design. Mr. Holcomb’s email address is: holcombpaul@co.kane.il.us.

Statements of Interest received will be used by County engineering staff to develop a short-list of three (3) firms. The County will then submit a Request for Proposal (RFP) from the three firms.

FABYAN PARKWAY / SETTLERS HILL ROAD INTERSECTION PRELIMINARY SCOPE OF SERVICES

Introduction

Phase II engineering services are required for Intersection improvements and Traffic Signal Modernization at the referenced intersection. Improvements will generally consists of auxiliary left and right turn lanes, drainage, resurfacing, landscaping, permanent traffic signals, and new pavement marking. Additional work will include a topographic survey, Right of Way Plats (if necessary), preparation of an Intersection Design Study, bid documents consisting of specifications, Estimate of time required, and an Engineer's Opinion of Probable Costs.

The project will be completed under the guidelines in IDOT's BLR manual and Traffic Signal Design Guidelines (latest editions). The consultant will also be required to certify that the design complies with the Kane County Stormwater Ordinance. Coordination with the Kane County Forest Preserve and Kane County Building and Grounds will also be required. A preliminary estimate of construction cost for this project is \$1,200,000.

Deliverables

The consultant will make three major submittals (preliminary, pre-final and final) of plans, specifications and estimates to KDOT.
