AMENDMENT TO PROJECT AGREEMENT

State: ILLINOIS

Project Amendment No. FOUR

THIS AMENDMENT to Project Agreement No. 17-00066 is hereby made and agreed upon by the United States of America, acting through the Director of the National Park Service and by the State of ILLINOIS pursuant to the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act of 1965, 78 Stat. 897 (1964).

The State and the United States, in mutual consideration of the promises made herein and in the agreement of which this is an amendment, do promise as follows:

That the above mentioned agreement is amended by adding the following:

Delete 6.4 acres from the 6f boundary at Hickory Hills Park due to a conversion of use (roadway) and replacement property will be provided within one year.

In all other respects the agreement of which this is an amendment, and the plans and specifications relevant thereto, shall remain in full force and effect. In witness thereof the parties hereto have executed this amendment as of the date entered below.
