2018 Resurfacing Program Kane County Section No. 17-00485-00-RS

Patching Work for the Annual County Resurfacing program is scheduled to begin on Fabyan Parkway between Bent Tree Dr. and Western Ave. the week of **August 20, 2018, weather permitting. This work will occur using temporary daily lane closures and flaggers directing traffic between the hours of 6:00 am until 5:00 pm Monday thru Friday.** The roadwork will consist of milling and resurfacing approximately 500 feet of both outside lanes of Fabyan Parkway for the eastbound and westbound directions. **This work is anticipated to take approximately one week to complete, weather permitting.** Listed below are the portions of Fabyan Parkway that will receive the patching.

County Highway	From	To	Activity
Fabyan Parkway	750' East of Bent Tree Dr.	1200' East of Bent Tree Dr.	Asphalt Patching

The above-mentioned road will remain open during construction. Motorists should expect very long delays while traveling through the work areas and should add additional time to their commutes. Motorists are asked to reduce their speed, watch for construction workers and vehicles entering or leaving the site, obey flaggers and comply with traffic control devices within the work zone. Motorists may want to avoid this area and/or consider the use of alternate routes while this work is being completed

A reminder – **it is illegal for drivers to talk on a cell phone while driving through a highway construction work zone.**

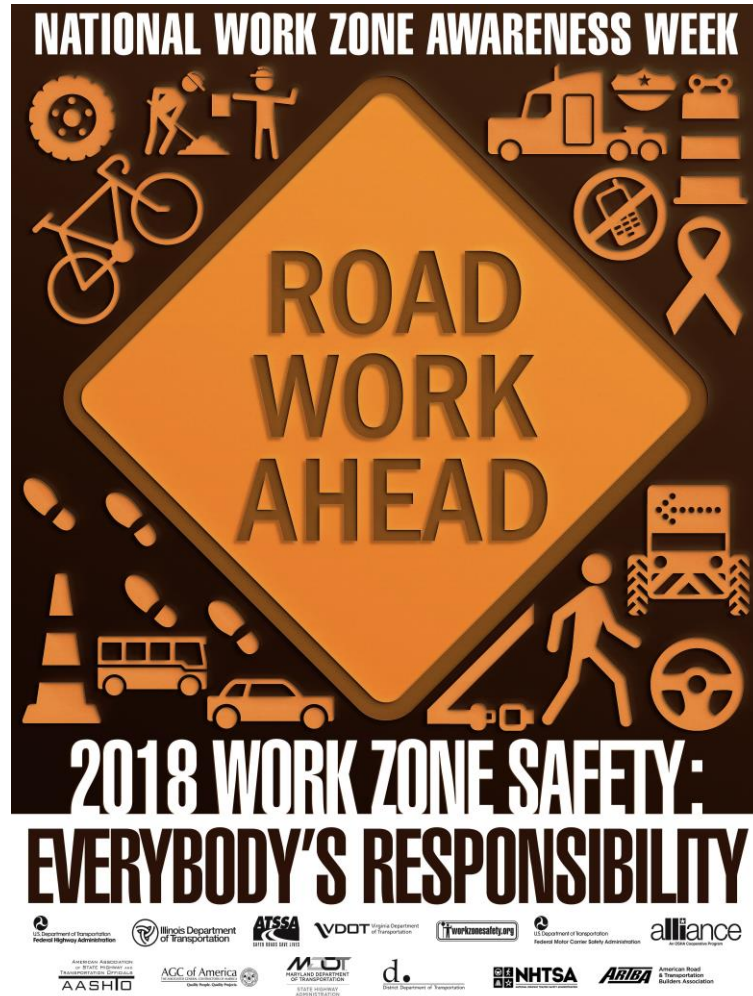

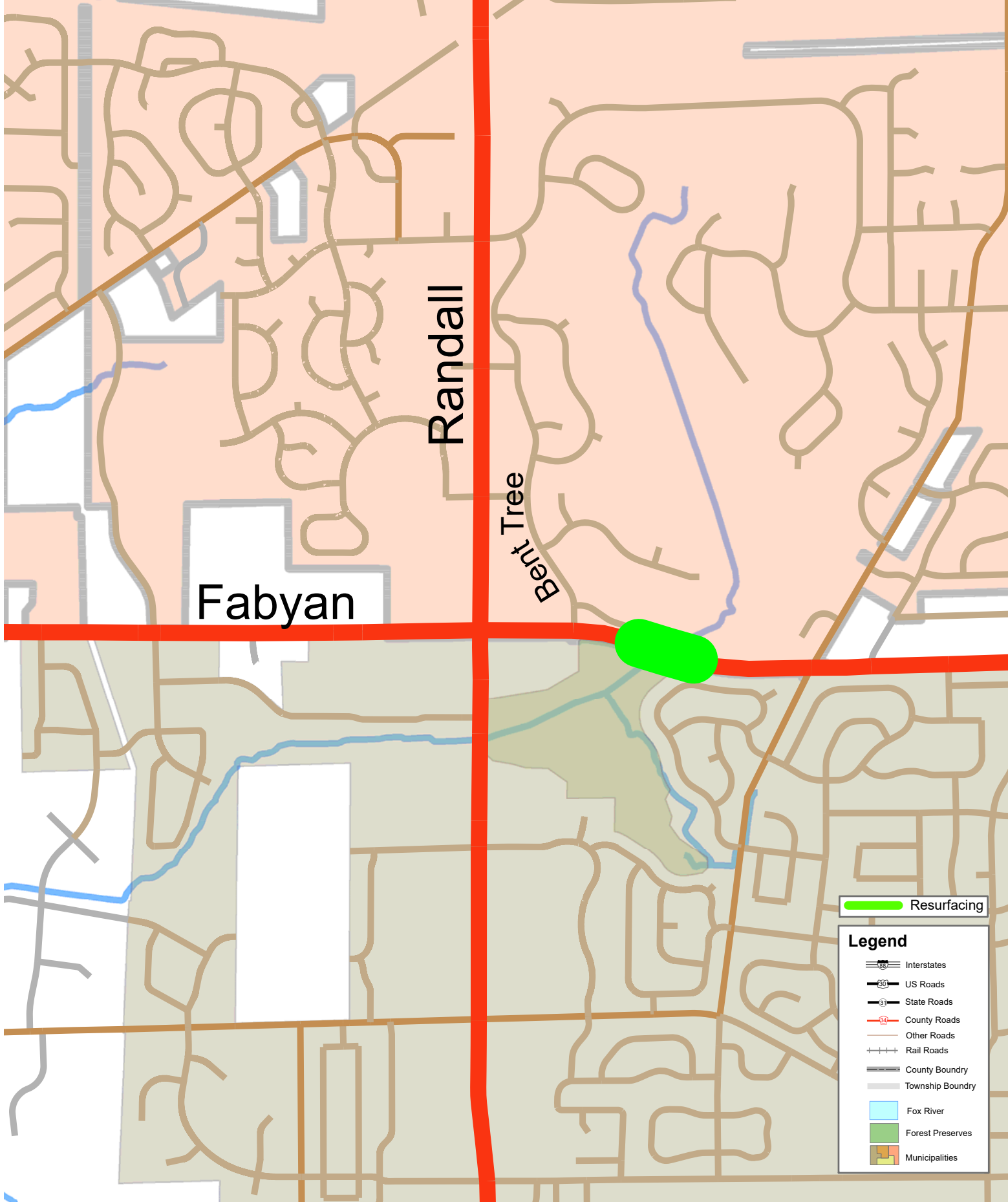

Work Zone Safety Alert

Drivers in this project area should be prepared to reduce their speed, exercise caution, watch for construction workers and construction vehicles entering or leaving the site, and obey flaggers and other traffic control devices within the work zone. Drivers should expect delays and may want to add additional time to their commutes and consider the use of alternate routes while this work is completed. KDOT reminds drivers that it is illegal to talk on a cell phone or text while driving through a highway construction work zone. The minimum penalty for speeding in a work zone is \$375.
