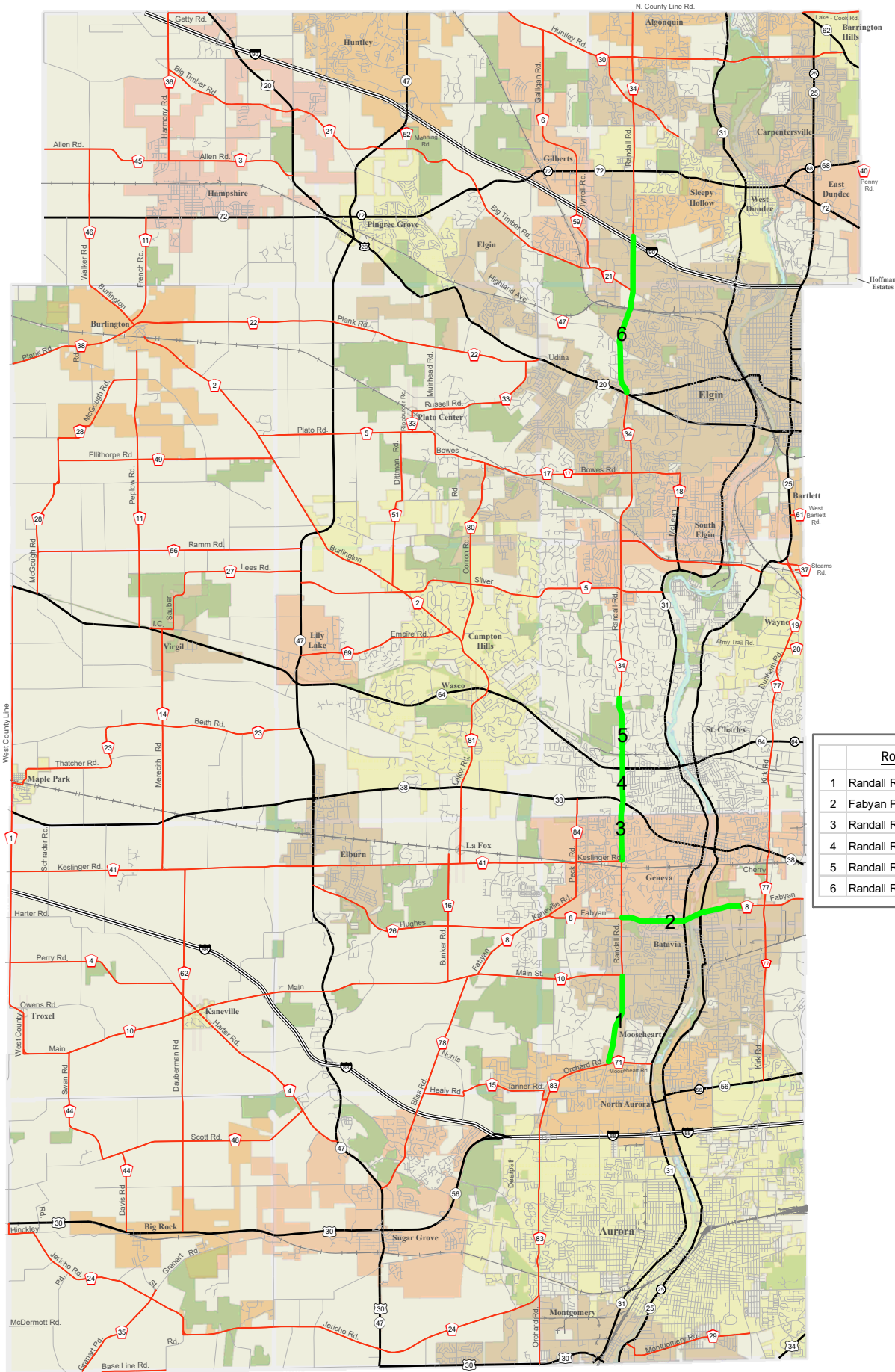

2023 Kane County Urethane Pavement Marking Program

August 30, 2023 - The annual Kane County Urethane Pavement Marking Program will begin the week of September 5, 2023, weather permitting. The work shall include placement of urethane pavement markings onto 13.5 miles of County highways as indicated on the attached maps. The County's typical process is to apply urethane pavement markings on the high volume County highways improving the visibility of the lane markings for the motoring public. The work is anticipated to be completed by the end of September, weather dependent.

Temporary daily lane closures will be required Monday through Friday from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM to safely accomplish this work. Overnight work may occur during this time between the hours of 8:00 PM and 5:00 AM in order to lessen the impact to traffic.

Flagger control of intersections will be required along the entire route in order to safely accomplish the required work. Please exercise caution while traveling in freshly painted areas.
