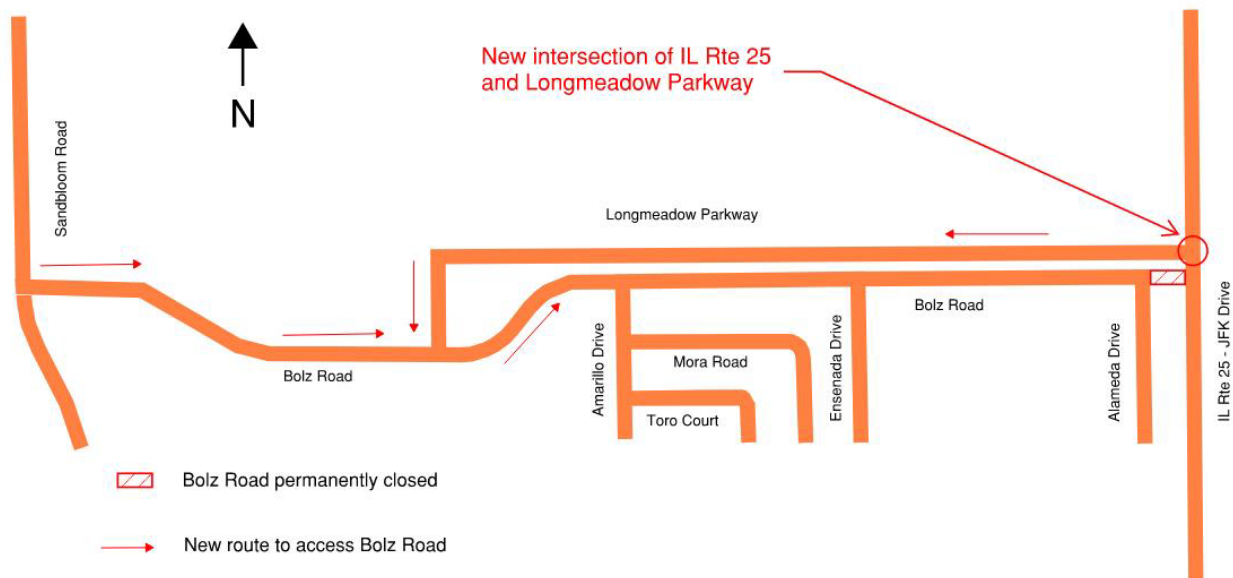

Longmeadow Parkway Section C2 PERMANENT ROAD CLOSURE OF A PORTION OF BOLZ ROAD Kane County Section No. 19-00215-24-PV

Beginning Wednesday, November 18th, existing Bolz Road will no longer directly connect to IL Route 25 and the Bolz Road leg of the intersection will be removed and closed permanently. Access to Bolz Road will be shifted to the new intersection at Longmeadow Parkway and IL Route 25 as shown below.

Local traffic will now access Bolz Road from the west using Sandbloom Road and from the east using the new intersection at Longmeadow Parkway. This closure was planned as part of the overall Longmeadow Parkway Bridge Corridor improvement.



As this area is still an active work zone, motorists should occasionally expect delays while traveling through the work areas, exercise caution, watch for construction workers and vehicles entering or leaving Longmeadow Parkway, obey flaggers and comply with traffic control devices within the work zone.

A reminder – **it is illegal for drivers to talk on a cell phone while driving through a highway construction work zone.**
