Fabyan Parkway at Kirk Road Intersection Improvement Kane County Section No. 11-00201-04-CH

Traffic is expected to be shifted to the temporary pavement along Kirk Road and along Fabyan Parkway the week of March 23, 2020 weather permitting. The shift will push traffic towards the west along Kirk Road and to the south along Fabyan Parkway. This shift in traffic will allow workers access in order to continue staged construction operations in a safe manner. Two lanes of traffic in each direction will be maintained on Kirk Road and Fabyan Parkway, but may temporary daily lane closures and flaggers may be needed primarily from 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

This work is part of the overall intersection reconstruction improvement Project, located on Fabyan Parkway from Kingsland Drive to Paramount Parkway, and on Kirk Road approximately 1,500 feet north and south of the intersection. Additional turn lanes and through lanes will increase safety and improve traffic operations of the intersection. The anticipated completion date for the project is September 30, 2020, weather permitting. The work consists of tree removal and replacement, earth excavation, storm sewer and drainage structures, water main relocation, hot-mix asphalt pavement, concrete pavement and sidewalk, curb and gutter installation, traffic signal modernization and lighting, shared use path and landscape restoration.

Since this improvement is at an existing busy intersection, longer than normal traffic delays are expected during construction. The above-mentioned roads will remain open during construction, but may include temporary daily lane closures and flaggers may be needed primarily from 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. Motorists should expect delays while traveling through the work areas and should add additional time to their commutes. Motorists are asked to reduce their speed, watch for construction workers and vehicles entering or leaving the site, obey flaggers and comply

with traffic control devices within the work zone. Motorists may want to consider the use of alternate routes while this work is being completed.

A reminder – **it is illegal for drivers to talk on a cell phone while driving through a highway construction work zone.**

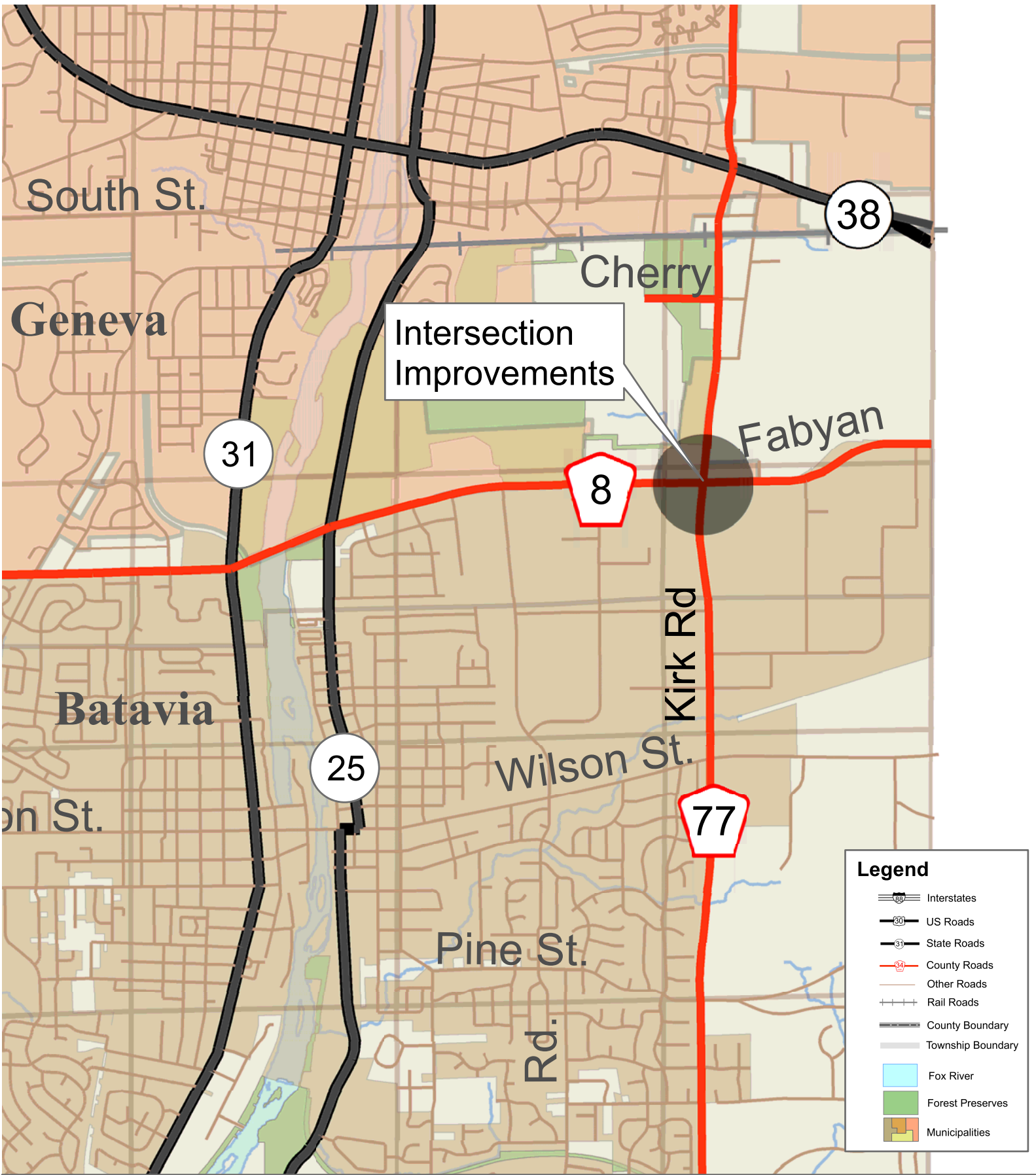

Work Zone Safety Alert

Drivers in this project area should be prepared to reduce their speed, exercise caution, watch for construction workers and construction vehicles entering or leaving the site, and obey flaggers and other traffic control devices within the work zone. Drivers should expect delays and may want to add additional time to their commutes and consider the use of alternate routes while this work is completed. KDOT reminds drivers that is illegal to talk on a cell phone or text while driving through a highway construction work zone. The minimum penalty for speeding in a work zone is \$250.
