## Kane County ADA Ramp Improvements Project

March 20, 2023 - Starting the week of March 27<sup>th</sup>, weather dependent, work will begin removing and replacing portions of sidewalk at the intersections of Bowes Rd and Randall Rd, Bowes Rd and McLean Blvd and Bowes Rd and Spring St. to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. Each crossing will have portions of the sidewalks and curb and gutter removed and replaced with new detectable warnings. Each removal area will be closed for 5 days at a time to allow for concrete removal, replacement, and curing. Pedestrians are asked to please avoid use of these portions of walk during the removal and replacement process.

Work is anticipated to begin at the intersection of Randall and Bowes and move east and south to Mclean and Spring. Signs indicating start dates will be posted at each route approximately one week prior to starting construction at the crossing. This project is expected to be complete in approximately four months, weather permitting.

The above-mentioned roads and intersections will remain open, but may be reduced to one lane of travel during construction using flaggers and temporary daily lane closures.
