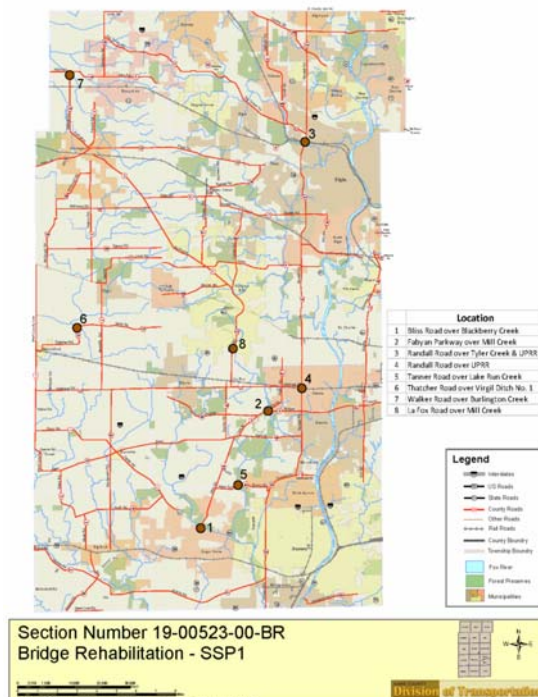
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## Kane County Bridge Rehabilitation Program

June 21, 2021 - Beginning this week, work will begin on the County's Bridge Rehabilitation Program on the below-listed structures. Construction work hours will be from 7:00 am until 5:00 pm Monday through Saturday for approximately 3 months, weather permitting.

- Bliss Road over Blackberry Creek
- Fabyan Parkway over Mill Creek
- Randall Road over Tyler Creek & UP RR
- Randall Road over UP RR
- Tanner Road over Lake Run Creek
- Thatcher Road over Virgil Ditch No. 1
- Walker Road over Burlington Creek
- La Fox Road over Mill Creek (South Crossing)

The Bridge Rehabilitation Program is part of the County's comprehensive maintenance program to increase the longevity of the County's bridges by sealing, cleaning and repairing portions of these structures in order to increase longevity.
