



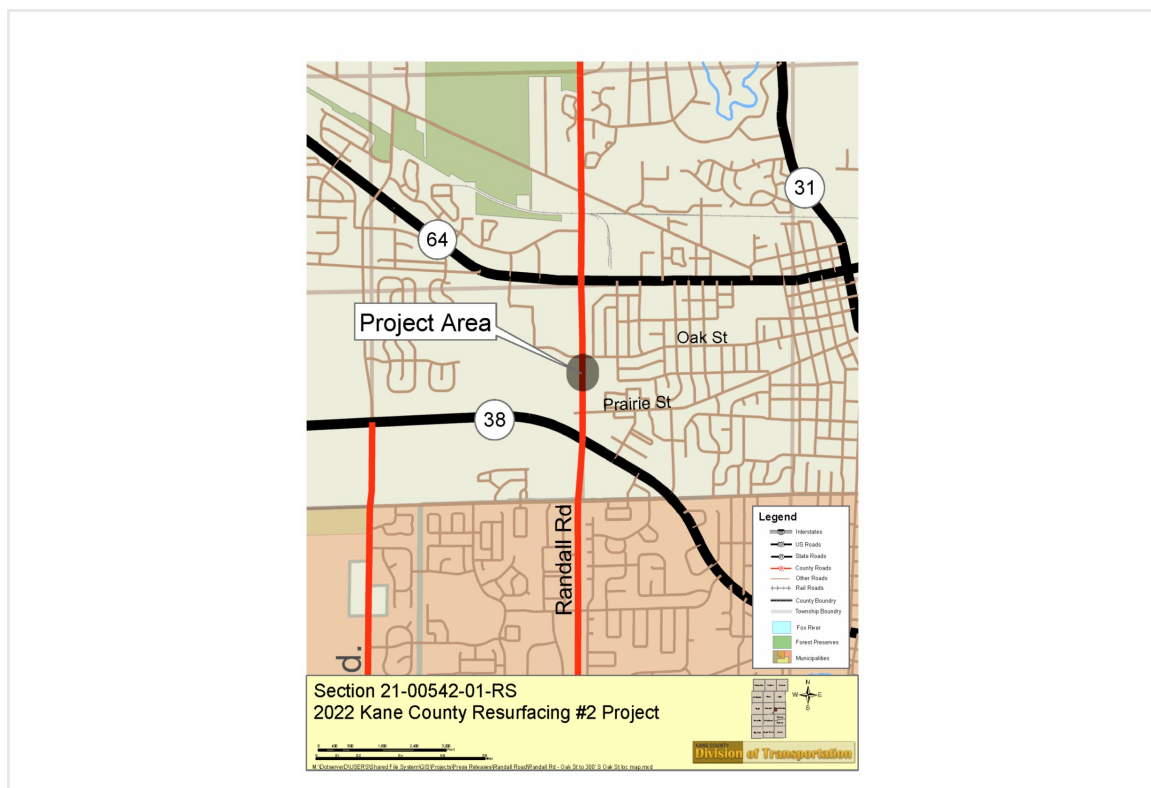
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Kane County Resurfacing Program #2 - Randall Road Repair Work

September 13, 2022 - The annual County Resurfacing Program #2 will continue with work on Randall Road between IL 38 and Oak St. scheduled to begin the week of Monday, September 19th, weather permitting. The repair work will consist of removal and replacement of asphalt in the northbound driving lanes, with working hours from 4:00 AM to 4:00 PM during the week, weather permitting. Lane closures of the northbound lanes are scheduled to begin at 4:00 AM, and continue throughout the day as the crews remove and replace the pavement base. The work will be located on the northbound lanes only, with one lane closed at a time and traffic directed to the adjacent available lane.

Residents are advised to add more time to their commute, expect delays if traveling through this section of Randall Road, and to consider planning an alternate route, if possible. The duration of the work is expected to be completed within one week. The pavement repair will be left a few inches low and properly ramped for later installation of the asphalt wearing surface in the coming months.
