Longmeadow Parkway – Randall Road to Karen Drive New Construction Kane County Section No. 13-00215-10-PV

Starting Friday August 18, 2017, weather permitting, the north leg of White Chapel Road at Longmeadow Parkway will be closed to allow construction crews room to place new pavement. The north part of the intersection will remain closed to traffic for an estimated 2 to 3 weeks. Traffic will still have access to the south leg of White Chapel at Longmeadow Parkway during this work. Motorists are asked to find alternate routes during the work period and to avoid the intersection if possible.

Motorists are further asked to exercise care and reduce speed while driving through the construction zone, obey flaggers and watch out for construction equipment entering and leaving the project site.

The Longmeadow Parkway Fox River Bridge Corridor is a planned tree-lined parkway and Fox River Bridge crossing with a landscaped median, approximately 5.6 miles in length, running from Huntley Road to IL Route 62. The proposed road passes through portions of the villages of Algonquin, Carpentersville and Barrington Hills, as well as unincorporated areas of Kane County and will provide a valuable benefit to the public by relieving congestion, encouraging economic development, improving travel options and connecting towns and neighborhoods.


