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## Press Release

### **Randall Road at McDonald/Stearns Road Intersection Improvement Kane County Section No. 14-00214-28-CH**

Construction is scheduled to begin the week of April 8, 2019 on the Randall Road at McDonald/Stearns Intersection Improvement Project, located on Randall Road from Thornwood Ave. to Gyorr Rd., and on McDonald/Stearns Road from Robin Glen Lane to 500 feet east of Randall Road. The anticipated duration for the project is approximately **eight months**, weather permitting. The work consists of Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) grind and overlay resurfacing, pavement widening to build a new northbound and southbound through lane on Randall Road, construction of a new combination concrete curb and gutter, new guardrail, new drainage structures and storm sewer, construction of a new permeable HMA multi-use path, construction of new roadway lightning, traffic signal improvements, construction of a new soldier pile wall, ditch regrading, landscaping, handicap accessible ramp improvements and new detectable warnings, restoration, and all incidental and collateral work necessary to complete the project.

The above-mentioned roads will remain open during construction, but may include temporary daily lane closures and flaggers primarily from 9:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. Motorists should expect delays while traveling through the work areas and should add additional time to their commutes. Motorists are asked to reduce their speed, watch for construction workers and vehicles entering or leaving the site, obey flaggers and comply with traffic control devices within the work zone. Motorists may want to consider the use of alternate routes while this work is being completed.

**A reminder – it is illegal for drivers to talk on a cell phone while driving through a highway construction work zone.**

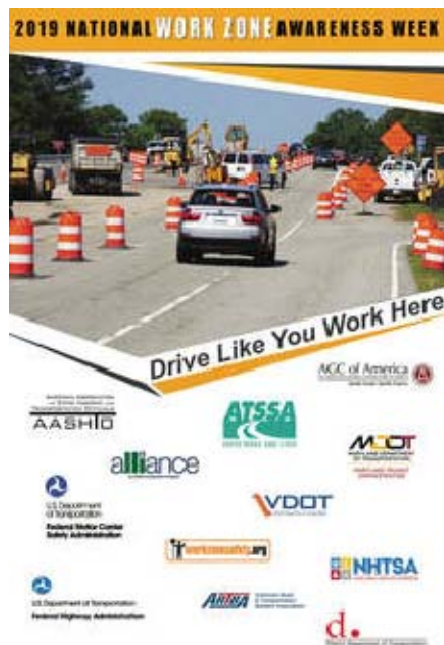

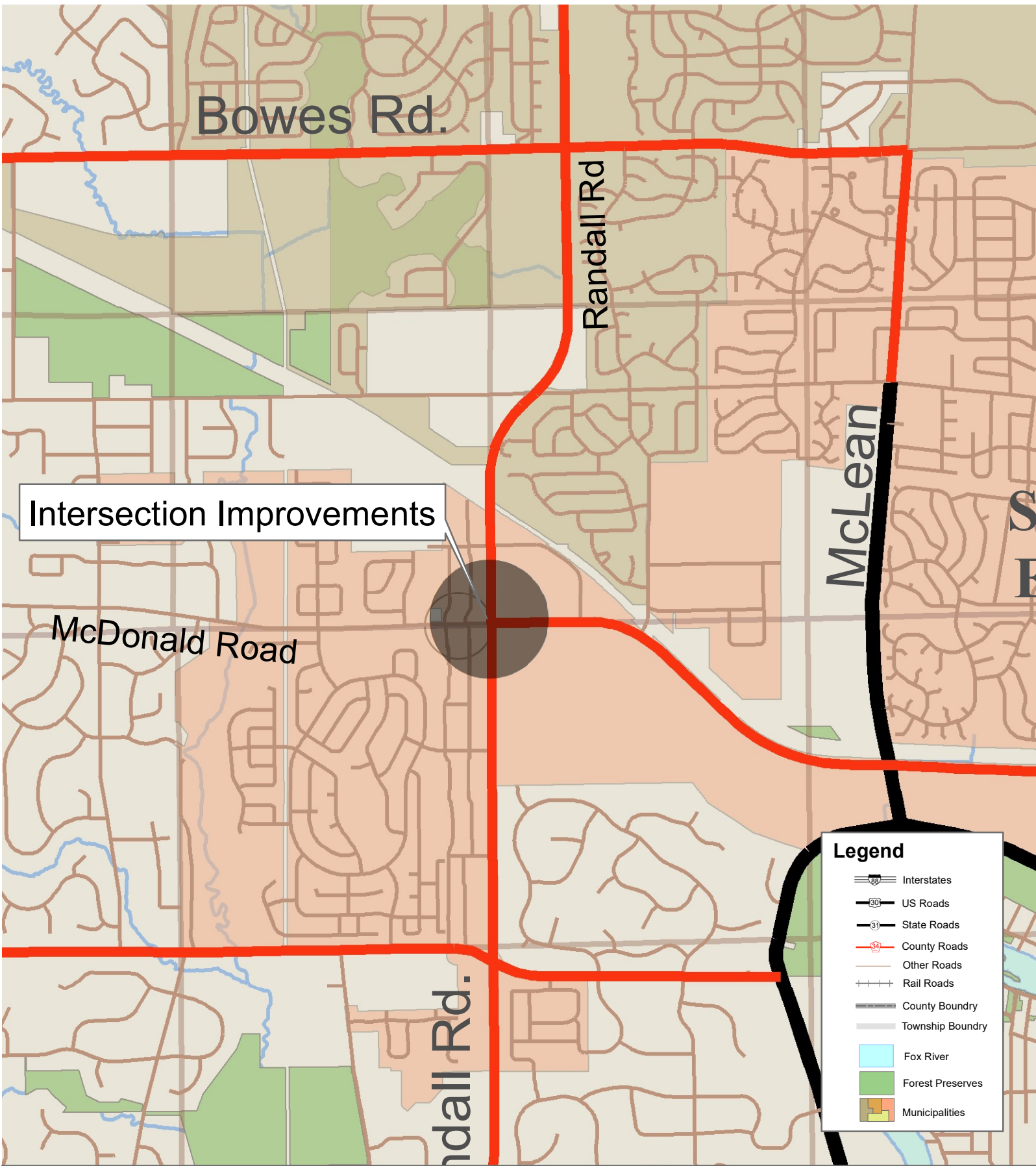

## Work Zone Safety Alert

Drivers in this project area should be prepared to reduce their speed, exercise caution, watch for construction workers and construction vehicles entering or leaving the site, and obey flaggers and other traffic control devices within the work zone. Drivers should expect delays and may want to add additional time to their commutes and consider the use of alternate routes while this work is completed. KDOT reminds drivers that it is illegal to talk on a cell phone or text while driving through a highway construction work zone. The minimum penalty for speeding in a work zone is \$375.
