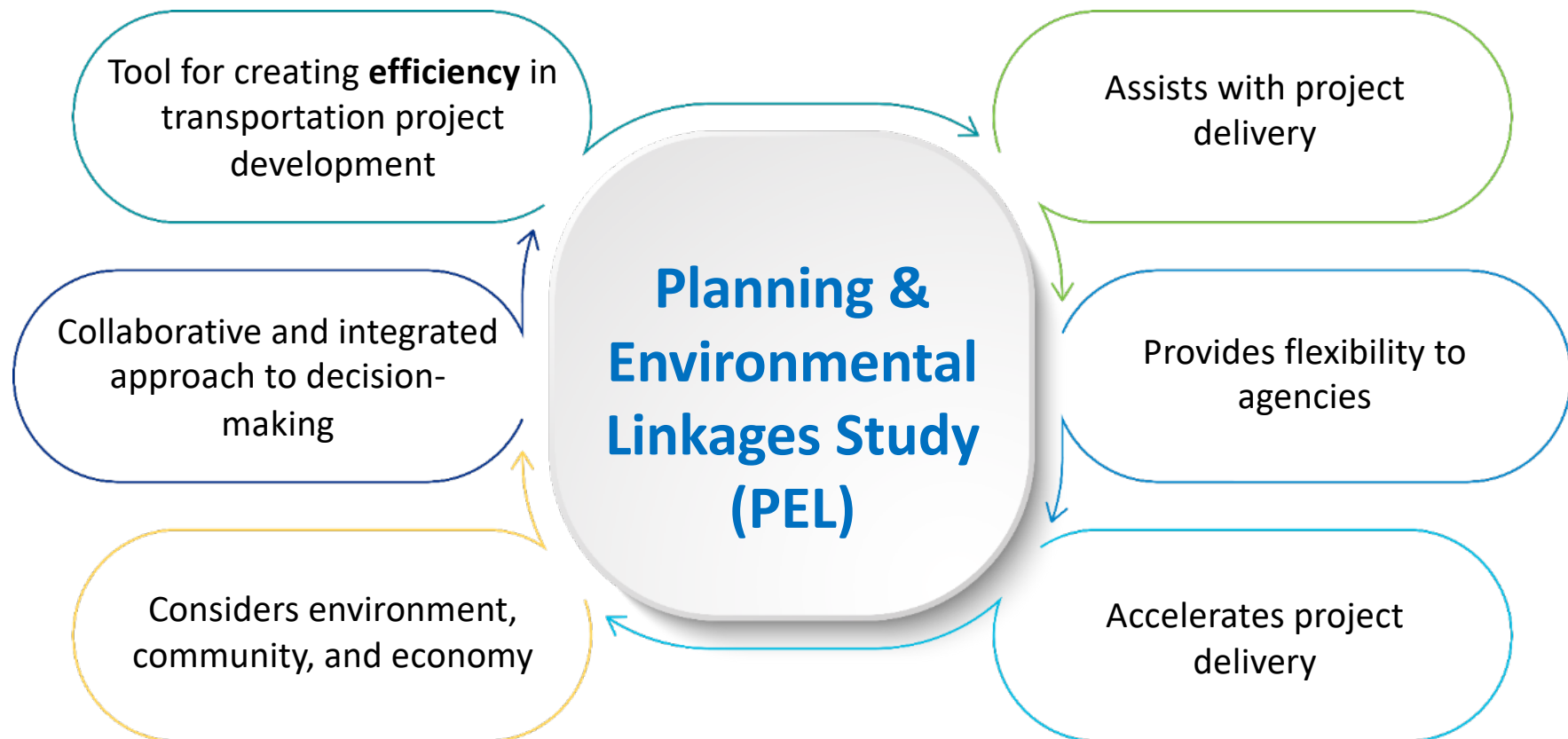

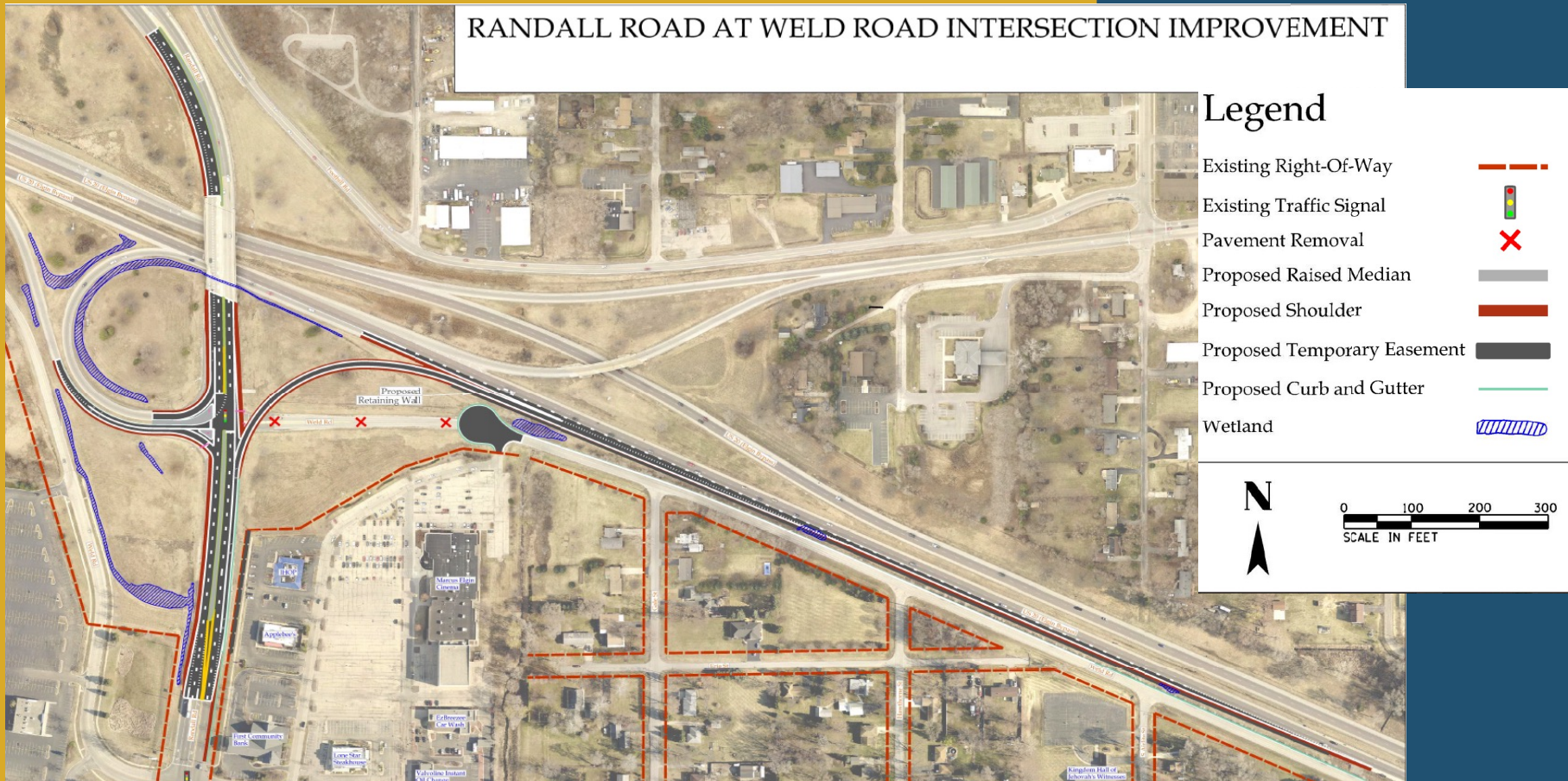

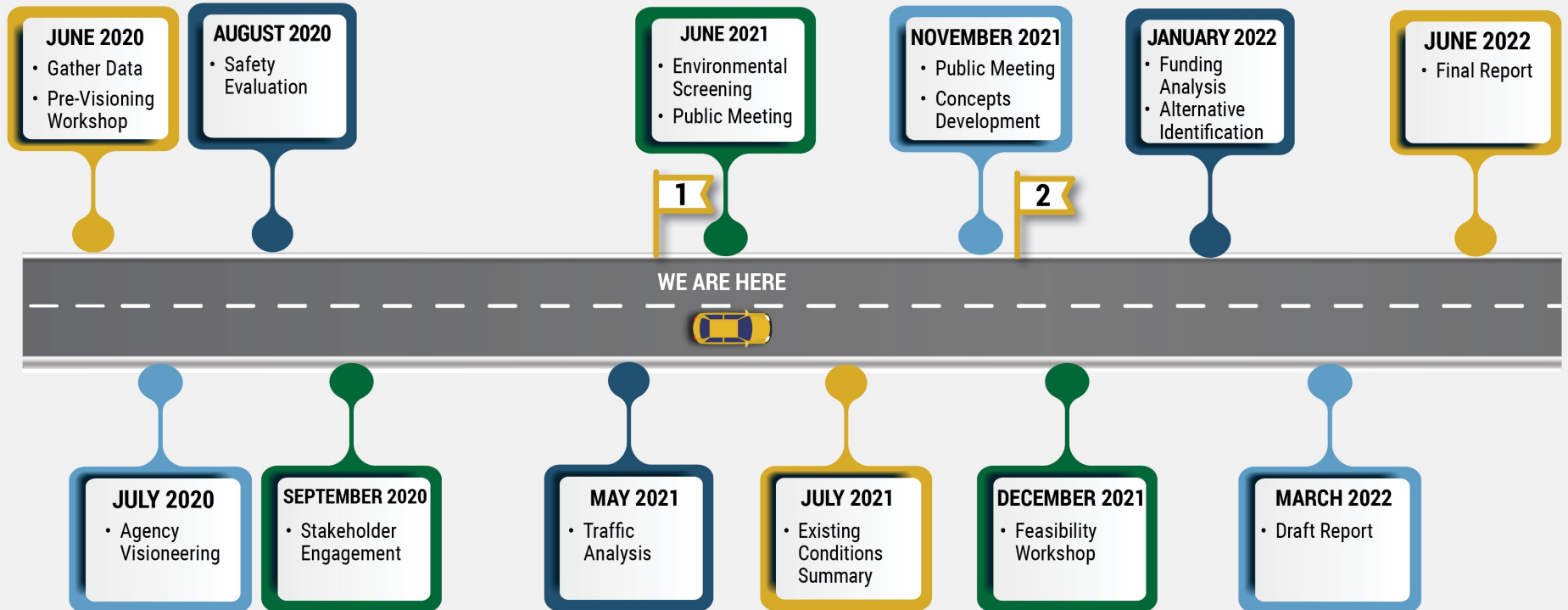

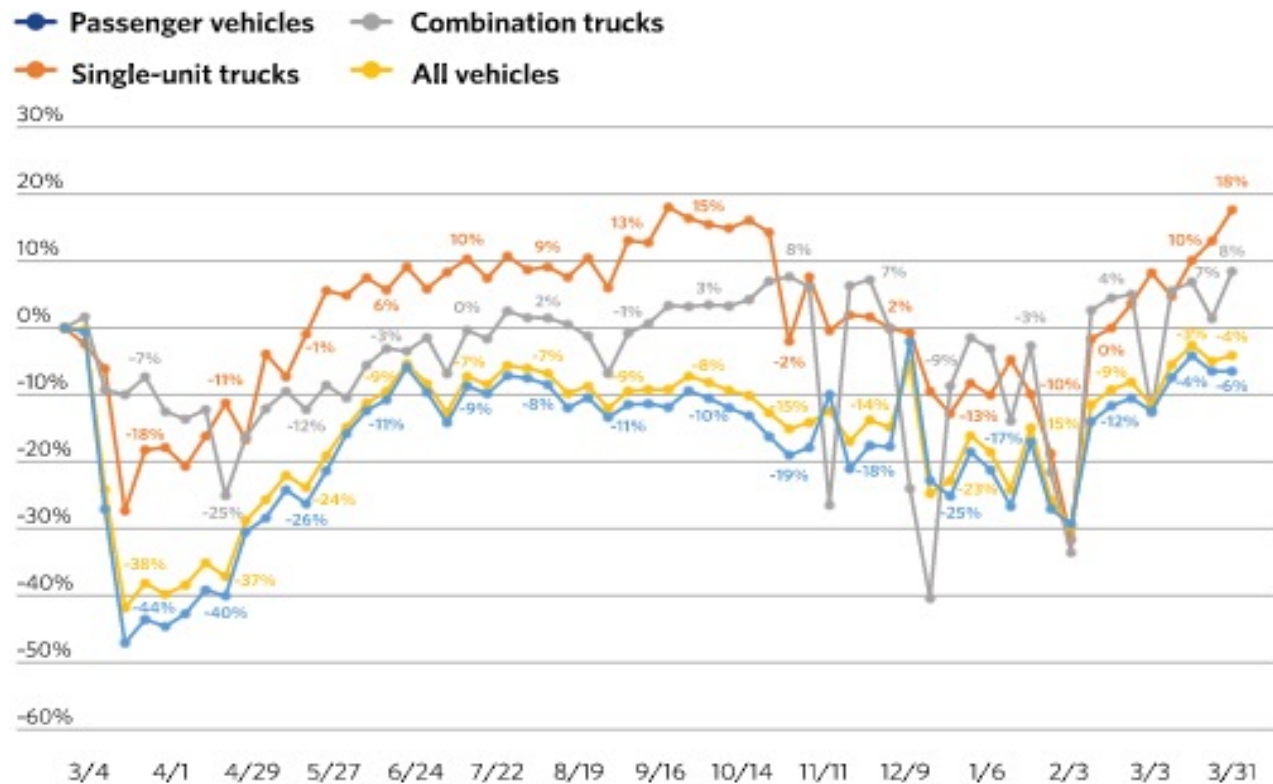

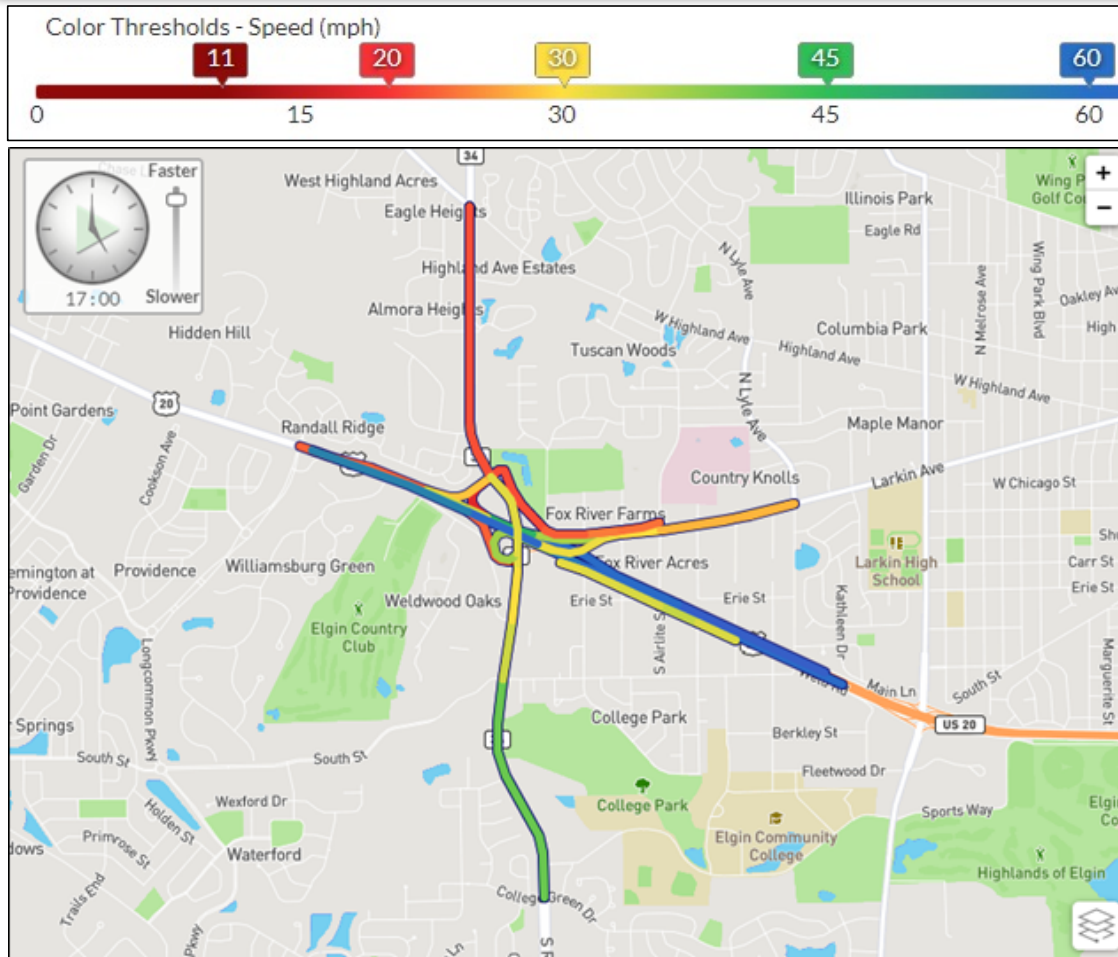
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Existing Conditions – Travel Times/Speeds



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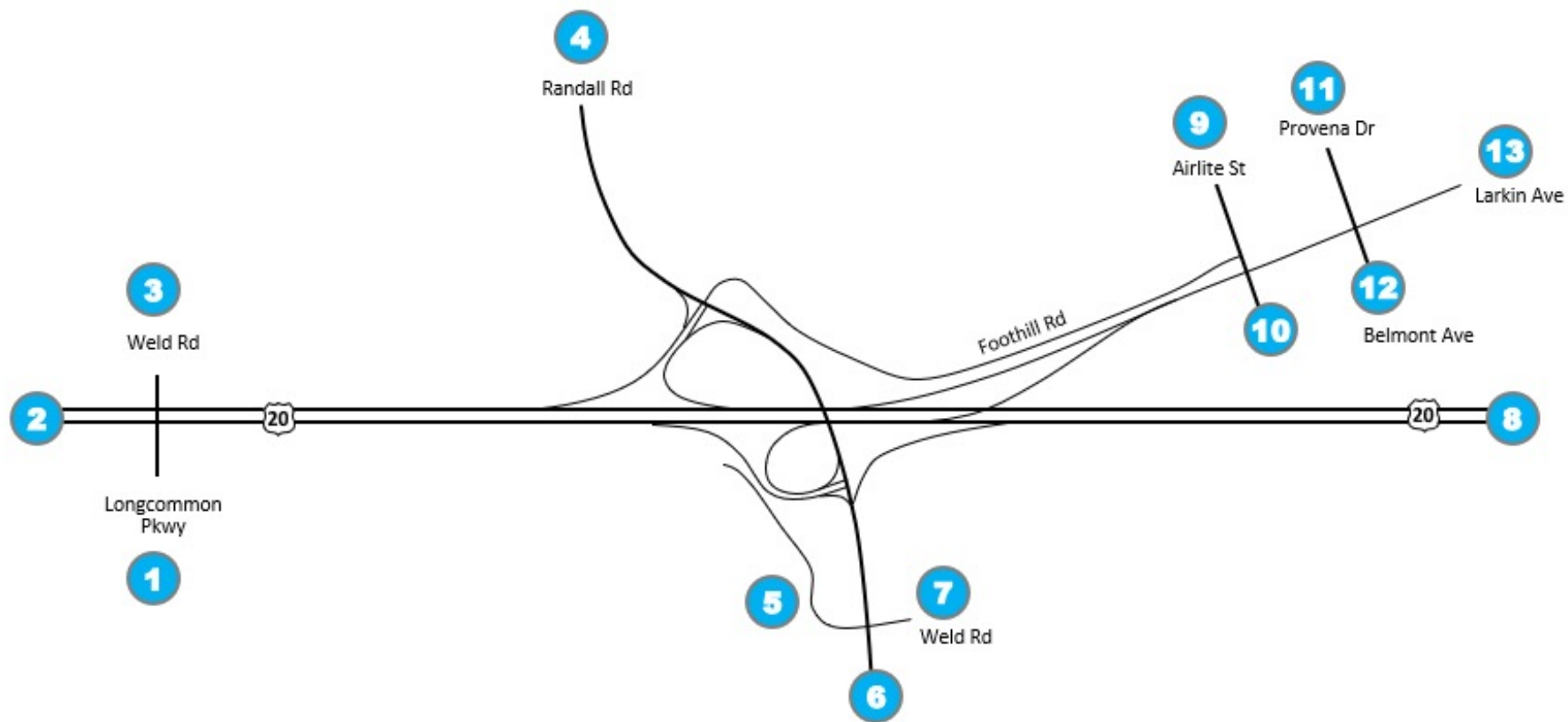
- Randall Southbound

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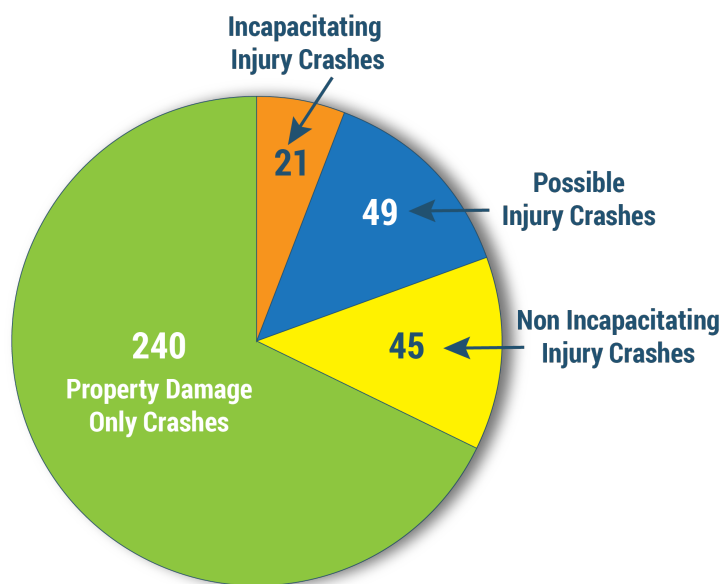
